They are able to assess and understand their strengths and limitations in order to support their learning and personal development.</p>	<p>In the library students are encouraged to reflect on the importance of literature and information as a way of understanding one's self and others.</p>	<p><u><b>The student:</b></u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>-discusses and reflects following presentations</b></li> <li><b>-makes connections</b></li> <li><b>-thinks about sequencing, predicting</b></li> <li><b>-will choose, act, reflect</b></li> <li><b>-uses self assessment and group assessment</b></li> <li><b>-chooses appropriate reading materials and reading level</b></li> <li><b>-helps and supports fellow students</b></li> </ul>	<p><u>Student Actions</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-assessment sheets after a research unit</li> <li>-evaluation then discussion</li> <li>-self reflection of learning &amp; presentation</li> <li>-thinks about ways to improve performance</li> <li>-welcome peer feedback</li> <li>-write book reviews</li> <li>-students share how they found information and how would they do it differently if they did it again.</li> <li>-uses library time efficiently - time management, use of resources-uses library as place for independent study</li> </ul> <p><u>Teacher Librarian Actions</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Creates reflection &amp; self-assessment instruments for after research unit</li> <li>-Provides opportunities for students to discuss reading through guided activities (book reviews, collaborative groups, etc.)</li> <li>-Talks with students about ways to improve research performance and reading</li> <li>-Provides opportunities for students to self-select research topics &amp; reading materials.</li> </ul>
